



## **Replacing a Ceramic Fibre Seal**

- Switch kiln off.
- Make a template of the existing fibre shape.
- Secure the lid open.
- Wearing a mask and rubber gloves, scrape the old fibre off, and carefully dispose of.
- With an old long bladed knife, cut the replacement fibre strips to shape.
- With a garden spray, dampen the brickwork and fibre to be glued.
- Apply the adhesive thinly, evenly and quickly.
- Apply fibre piece to the lid, adjust, and then press on firmly.
- Try closing the lid to ensure a good flat seal.
- If you cut one piece wrong, there is enough material to cut another.

RCF ceramic fibre is considered a carcinogen.

Care should be taken.

Ceramic fibre is highly irritant.

We would supply body soluble fibre, the RCF free alternative.
