



Gas or electric?

An electric kiln is easier to use, as cheap to run, easier to control, does not need a vent or a chimney to the outside and is certainly cheaper to buy.

A gas kiln is usually a larger piece of equipment (to achieve the same internal size) because you need space for the flames. You will also need a chimney, flue etc. Gas kilns enable you to get that well sought-after reduction – which transforms glazes in a way that electric kilns can't.
